Dear Parents & Carers

This will be my final letter to you as Principal of Beamont Collegiate Academy.

Having first joined BCA as Vice Principal in 2014, I feel incredibly proud of all that the school community has achieved since that time. Over the last decade, the academy has grown in strength and reputation, and it has been a privilege to play a part in that journey alongside such a committed team of staff, governors, and trust leaders.

Together, we have secured strong academic outcomes for our students year on year, received two consecutive 'Good' judgements from Ofsted, and become one of the most oversubscribed secondary schools in Warrington.
